- Monday through Friday daily postings on WILD Foundation's Facebook and Twitter
- Monday through Friday daily postings on Nature Needs Half's Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram
- Finding articles, videos, and content to share
- Coordinating pre-scheduled Instagram content with WILD's Instagram manager
- Coordinating with WILD team members on planned content and specifically requested sharable content
- Staying up to date on Facebook ad policies and restrictions and taking the proper steps to ensure that WILD's platforms are always verified for ad sharing
- Managing incoming comments, shares, inboxes, DMs
- Weekly organization of posts by content type, demographic, date, among other things
- Working with WILD's data manager to critically analyze the performance of posts
- Support our Donor Relations Manager steward existing donors a few times a year by preparing physical mailings
- Managing social posts and weekly basic content creation for one or two of WILD's specific projects
